In April 2003 we were involved in an international **Wetlands Archaeological Research Programs** conference entitled: *Wet Sites Connections—Linking Indigenous Histories, Archaeology and the Public* (us!) bringing international archaeologists together to discuss waterlogged/wet archaeological sites from around the world in Olympia, Washington.
